This approval have been accorded subject to fulfillment of specific and general conditions as follows:

i. The admission will be made in accordance with Regulations notified by the AICTE vide GSR 476(E) dated 28.02.1993 and in conformity with the Hon'ble Supreme Court Judgement dated 04.02.1993 with regard to WP(C) No. 607 of 1992 in the case of Unni Krishnan v. State Government of Andhra Pradesh and others etc. and later judgements. No Management/Institute/Trust or Society shall be permitted to admit students directly under any circumstances. Any action contrary to this provision taken by the institute will be derecognised.

ii. Further in the event of infringement/contravention or non-compliance of the conditions prescribed by the Council, the Council shall take further action to withdraw approval to these cases for admission during 1997-98 and the such withdrawal of approval will be solely that of Management/Trust/Society and/or Institutions.

You are requested to kindly monitor the progress of the cases by these institutions.

### General Conditions :

1. There shall be a separate governing Council for the institution and it shall be constituted as per the guidelines prescribed by AICTE from time to time.
2. The infrastructural, instructional and other facilities including teaching staff, equipment etc. shall be provided as per AICTE norms prescribed from time to time.
3. A building with required space as per AICTE norms shall be provided exclusively for this programme.
4. A library shall be established with adequate titles, books, journals (both Indian and Foreign).
5. A Computer center with adequate number of terminals etc. shall be established.
6. No new course(s) shall be started or any ongoing course shall not be discontinued and no increase in intake shall be made in the courses without prior approval of the governing body.
7. The teaching staff shall be in the pay-scales as per AICTE guidelines prescribed from time to time.
8. The faculty should be recruited as per norms, qualifications etc. as prescribed by the AICTE from time to time and the selection committee for recruitment shall have the representation of the University / State Government and the AICTE also.
9. a) The admissions shall be made only after adequate infrastructure and other facilities are provided as per norms and guidelines of AICTE / Govt. of India.  
b) Admissions shall be made on merits as per the guidelines of the AICTE.
10. The tuition and other fees shall be charged as per the guidelines of the Competent Authority within the overall criteria prescribed by the AICTE from time to time.
11. The administrative, academic and financial records and accounts shall be maintained for this programme and the accounts shall be audited annually by Chartered Accountants. All the records and reports shall be open for inspection by the AICTE or its nominee.

14. The Management shall follow all conditions as laid down by the AICTE from time to time and a request for undertaking to this effect shall be submitted to the Council.
15. The Institute by virtue of the approval given shall not automatically become claimant to grant or assistance from Central or State Government.
16. The information furnished in respect of the progress shall be factual and correct. In the event of any information found to be false, misleading or suppressed, the approval accorded may be withdrawn by the AICTE.
17. The Institute shall furnish requisite returns as desired by the AICTE in order to ensure proper maintenance of administrative and academic standards. Annual report on fulfillment of the above conditions shall be submitted on 31st November, and 31st May of each year shall be submitted by the Institution to the AICTE.
18. The institution shall not charge any capitation fee or contribution for admission or other higher charges from the parents or guardians of the students in any form.
19. The State Govt. policies of SC/ST other weaker sections and backward society etc. shall be followed by the institution.
20. An Expert Committee of this Council shall visit the Institute by December of last approved academic year to check the compliance of the conditions as laid down and shall make necessary recommendations for further improvement.
